Activity	Football training & Match days	Locations	Irlam FC, Silver Street, Irlam. External training venues

This document relates to the biological risk of COVID 19 to all persons participating in/attending Irlam JFC footballing activities.

This assessment has determined that there is no specific requirement for PPE except in first aid situations, and applies to all training sessions and matches held at Irlam Football Club

Covid 19 Symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Before travelling to a session person attending must check symptoms and stay home if they display any symptoms as outlined by the NHS (High temperature, a new or continuous cough, loss or change to sense of smell or taste). Parents should inform the lead coach and test/isolate as per Government guidelines.• The lead coach for each team should ensure a record of all attendees is maintained as per the government track & trace guidance, either via attendance apps relevant to individual teams or via centralised email to trackandtrace@irlamjfc.co.uk• In the event of a positive COVID test of any individual related to the club, it is the duty of the Club Officials to notify the relevant authority/persons as per track & trace guidance.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parents/Spectators can register their own attendance via the Survey Monkey app signposted at the ground and via the team coaches.

<p>Training sessions and Match days</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents are requested to drop their children at training and leave the area until the session is finished. If it is not possible for parents to wait in vehicles or return at the end of the session, then they are asked to maintain social distancing and only bubble with members of their own household. • You must only share a car with members of your household or support bubble. • Players and spectators are asked to arrive 'on time' for sessions and less than 15 mins before the start of training sessions or match day kick off. • Players and spectators are asked to leave the stadium immediately following any footballing activity. • Social distancing must be followed when entering and exiting the stadium. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents/Spectators can register their own attendance via the Survey Monkey app signposted at the ground and via the team coaches.
<p>First Aid</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First aid can only be administered in severe circumstances as per FA guidance, and only with the agreement of coach, player and parent. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate PPE is available in the event of an emergency first aid situation.
<p>Dugouts/Technical areas</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only club officials and players will have access to the dugouts and technical areas. • Each player is expected to have their own hand sanitizer 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer is available via the club official.

Spectator areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any spectators must follow social distancing whether in the standing or seated areas of the stadium. • Parents and spectators are expected to carry their own sanitizer and be responsible for their own personal hygiene. • On match days, parents and spectators must remain in 'spectator' areas only. The technical areas/dugouts are for the coach and players. Any other persons entering technical areas will be asked to leave the area, this includes siblings of players. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer is available in the clubhouse
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities will be planned in line with current Government and FA guidance. • Competitive training can take place with group of no more than 30, including coaches. • Competitive match play is allowed with social distancing in place during breaks in play. • Goal celebrations should be avoided. • Any spectator refusing to observe social distancing will be asked to leave the stadium. 	
Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All used cleaning materials should be disposed of appropriately. • Any personal waste items, i.e. bottles, food wrappers should be taken home by the individual and disposed of at home where possible. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bins are available within the stadium for disposal of items where it is not possible for them to be taken home by the individual.

Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean training equipment before and between use using suitable products. • Frequently clean objects and areas that are in regular use, for example goal posts, training equipment and dugouts. • Where possible equipment should only be handled by the coach/club officials. • Players should have their own drinks bottles. • Goalkeepers are responsible for sanitizing their gloves. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitizer is available in the clubhouse
Irlam FC Clubhouse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Card payment preferred* • Social distancing measures in place • One way system in place • Hand sanitizer at entrance & exit 	
Changing Rooms	<p>*Not currently in use for Junior teams but measures are in place for Senior teams as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of all changing rooms to allow for smaller groups. • Social distancing measures in place. • Separate entrance and exit in place for home and away teams. • Hand sanitizer in each changing room. 	
Refreshment Cabin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Card payment preferred* • Maximum of 2 volunteers serving • Queue outside following social distancing measures.
